Should only 55 people determine the future of <u>our</u> neighborhoods?

- Neighborhood input was systematically ignored during the Charrette in favor of the Developer's (Spire Realty) financial interests.
- NWACA and Spire have teamed up to actively promote the "Developer's Plan" to City Officials and locals.
- Of approximately 251 neighbors who participated in the Charrette process, only 55 voted for the "Developer's Plan."

NG (Neighborhood Goal as determined by the Vision and Values community meetings), **PUD** (the last proposed Spire PUD plan), **PP** (Charrette PUD Developer's "preferred plan")



NG: Minimize increased traffic; Current: 4,118 trips/day


PUD: over 17,000 trips/day **PP:** over 17,000 trips/day



NG: Reduce impact on Protected and Heritage Oaks

PUD: 9 Heritage Trees and 49+ Protected Trees impacted

PP: 19 Heritage Trees and 23 Protected Trees impacted



NG: Max height 5 stories (60ft.) per current zoning; 850K total square feet (mixed use)

PUD: 8 buildings, six at 7-10 stories; 1.280M total sf **PP:** 11 buildings, eight 5-7 stories; 1.196M total sf
